



ETTU U13 Camps 2025

HOSTING CONDITIONS AND APPLICATION PROCESS

- All Member Associations and Training Centres that are part of the Network of European Training Centres are eligible to apply as hosts.
- The deadline for submitting the Final Application Form is Friday, December 6, 2024.
- The main criteria for the hosts decision will be based on the evaluation of the application and avoiding clashing dates with Europe Youth Series Events and WTT Youth Events in Europe.
- Member Associations planning to host a camp alongside a Europe Youth Series Event should mention it in their application.
- ETTU will provide support to each organizer with a total amount of €2,000. This amount includes €1,600 to cover the fees of local coaches and €400 to cover additional organizational costs, such as water, fruits, snacks, etc.
- ETTU will collaborate with the host by assigning a Development Manager or ETTU Consultant Coach to assist with the organization of the camp.

GENERAL OVERVIEW

Continental Hopes - 1 Camp per year

Players born 2013 or later

Continental Hopes Camps are open to all players born 2013 or later. Players who are part of the Eurotalents group (selected in 2024) will receive the same support as in a Eurotalents camp, with ETTU covering accommodation for the player and one coach per association. For other players, conditions will be as in a selection camp, with ETTU covering part of the accommodation costs. The best performing players will be selected for ITTF Hopes.

Eurotalents - 2 camps per year.

For Selected Players

Eurotalents Camps are exclusively for players who have already been selected during the selection camps held in 2024 or who received a wildcard due to their international results. ETTU will fully cover the accommodation costs for these selected players, as well as for one coach per participating Member Association.

Selection - 2 camps per year.

Players born 2013 or later

The participation is open to all Member Associations. ETTU will partially cover the accommodation costs for one boy and one girl per Member Association. The best-performing players from each camp will be selected to participate in the Eurotalents U-13 Program in 2026.
