

1. INTRODUCTION

This Rulebook describes the European Table Tennis Ranking system, the ETTU table tennis competitions and events included in this system and the way the ranking is made out of the results of these events.

Only players eligible to represent an ETTU Member Association in accordance with ETTU Handbook Regulation B.1./B.1.1.2./ B.1.3./ B.1.4 can be ranked in the ETTU ranking list

2. EVENTS

In 2025, ETTU will create ranking list for the following age categories

- Men's Singles (MS)
- Women's Singles (WS)
- U21 Men's Singles (extraction from MS ranking)
- U21 Women's Singles (extraction from WS ranking)
- U19 Boys Singles
- U19 Girls Singles

- U13 Girls Singles

3. PUBLICATION OF RANKING

For each category, ETTU will publish a ranking list on the first Friday of a month after ITTF has published WR on the first Tuesday of that month.

5. RANKING PRINCIPLES

5.1. Tournament Weight:

The ETTU ranking events can be divided into 13 different tournament weights (TW):

TW:	0,4	European Under 21 Championships
TW:	0,3	no events in 2025

TW:	0,2	European Ranking International Sanctioned Events
TW:	0,1	European Ranking Regional Sanctioned Events
TW:	0,05	European Ranking U21 Sanctioned Events (International or Regional)

The ETTU EB will annually, latest by 15th December, announce the TW to be used for each European Ranking Event in the following year

* European Games - on August ranking points deduction from 1,0 to 0,5

5.2. Final Position Points

Players will receive points based on the final position in an event combined with the Tournament Weight of the event, according to the Points Table (Annex 1 of the European Ranking Rulebook)

5.3. Victory Points

For each win in a singles match, additional points (victory points) will be awarded, according to the Victory Points Table in Annex 2 of the European Ranking Rulebook.

The number of awarded points depends on the opponent's position on the actual ER.

or

If a defeated player is not a member of the ETTU member association, the number of victory points will be assigned according to Annex 3 of this Rulebook.

The Victory Points Table is described in Annex 2 of the European Ranking Rulebook.

5.4. Overall number of rewarded points on the tournament :

(TW)Final Position Points + Victory Points = Overall Number of Points

$$(TW)FPP + VP = ONP$$

5.5. Team Events Points

For each win in an singles match in a team event to be included in the European Ranking System, points (Victory Points) will be awarded according to the Points Table (Annex 2 of the European Ranking Rulebook).

The number of awarded points depends on the opponent's position on the actual ER (actual ER; described in 6.8.)

or

If a defeated player is not a member of the ETTU member association, the number of victory points will be assigned according to Annex 3 of this Rulebook.

Team events to be included in the European Ranking (MS/WS):

- European Teams Championships (ETC)
- European Teams Championships Qualification Stage 1 (ETQ)
- Olympic Games (OG)
- European Games (EG)
- World Teams Championships (WTC)
- European Champions League (ECL)
- Europe Cup (EC)
- Europe Trophy (ET)

Teams Events which will be included in the European Ranking (U13/U15/U19):

- European U19,U15 and U13 Teams Championships
- European Youth Series
- World U19 Teams Championships
- World U15 Teams Championships

5.6. Number of Events in Ranking Calculation

For the ranking calculation the following number of events will be calculated :

- Men's Singles four(4) best results
- Women's Singles four(4) best results
- U19 Boy's Singles three(3) best results
- U19 Girl's Singles three(3) best results
- U15 Boy's Singles four(4) best results
- U15 Girl's Singles four(4) best results
- U13 Boy's Singles four(4) best results
- U13 Girl's Singles four(4) best results

5.7. Correlation tournament/ranking

5.7.1. Ranking points will only be awarded in the ranking corresponding to the age category of the event in which the player participated.

Example:

Player participating at the EYS event in U13 event. Results from the U13 event will be counted only for the U13 ranking, not for U15 or senior ranking.

Exception:

Results from U21 events will be counted for senior ranking, as there is no separate U21 ranking. For U21, the ranking order will be an extract of the MS or WS European rankings.

- 5.7.2.** If players are participating in two different categories in the same senior tournament (MS/WS singles and U21): players will receive points for two different tournaments in the same ranking list

Example:

A player participating at the Europe Ranking Sanctioned event in MS and MS U21 categories. Points from the MS will be added to the MS result for that tournament, while points from the MS U21 will be added to the MS U21 result for that tournament

- 5.7.3.** If players are participating in two different categories in the same youth tournament: players will receive points for two different ranking lists

Example:

A player participating at the European Ranking Sanctioned event in U13 and U15 categories in the same tournament. Results from the U13 event will be counted only for the U13 ranking, and results from U15 will be counted only for the U15 ranking.

- 3 2nd highest ranked European player from that extraction will be awarded with points for 2nd position from Final Position Points Table (TW: 1,5)
- 4 On that principle all European players from extraction from WR will be awarded with points from the Final Position Points Table
- 5 In case more players have the same number of points - points will be awarded according to WR position.

All ETTU Member Associations can apply their International event to be part of the ETTU Ranking System.

An International tournament can be an ETTU ranking sanctioned event if following conditions are satisfied:

- minimum 5 Associations must participate at the event
- the entries must be done through the NA-s
- event shall not clash with other ETTU events
- ETTU has to approve competition dates and Prospectus
- Entry List - ITTF ID is mandatory
- extraction of results must be in specific form (TBA)
- The host Association must pay a fee of 500€ to ETTU, to be part of the ETTU Ranking System
- ER must be used for the Seeding List
- Tournament can't be part of WTT or ITTF tournament structure
- that events are also open for non European players.

Duration of Points : maximum one year

Points deduction: no

Final Position Points Table: **equal** or **each** depending on playing system.

For each event, the ETTU Ranking Committee will publish the Final Position Points table as part of the Prospectus

Victory points: for each win according to the European Ranking List that will be used for the Seeding List

Exception : Only players with ITTF ID will be included in ETTU Ranking

- minimum 4 Associations must participate at the event
- the entries must be done through the NA-s
- event shall not clash with other ETTU events
- ETTU has to approve competition dates and Prospectus
- Entry List - ITTF ID is mandatory
- extraction of results must be in specific form (TBA)
- The host Association must pay a fee of 300€ to ETTU, to be part of the ETTU Ranking System
- ER must be used for the Seeding List
- Tournament can't be part of WTT or ITTF tournament structure

- Tournament Weight: 0,1 (0,05 for U21 events)
- Duration of Points : maximum one year
- Points deduction: no
- Final Position Points Table: **equal** or **each** depending on playing system.
For each event, the ETTU Ranking Committee will publish the Final Position Points Table as part of the Prospectus
- Victory points: for each win according to European Ranking List which will be used for Seeding List

- The Regional Association must pay a fee of 200€ to ETTU, to be part of the ETTU Ranking System
- ER must be used for the Seeding List
- Tournament can't be part of WTT or ITTF tournament structure

- Tournament Weight: 0,1
- Duration of Points : maximum one year
- Points deduction: no
- Final Position Points Table: **equal** or **each** depending on playing system.
For each event, the ETTU Ranking Committee will publish the Final Position Points Table as part of the Prospectus
- Victory points: for each win according to European Ranking List which will be used for Seeding List

 Final Position Points Table: each
 Victory Points: no

Description of Extraction procedure :

WR which will be extracted for ER : WR from first Tuesday each month

Description of extraction procedure:

- 1 ETTU member Association players will be extracted from WR in order as in WR
- 2 The highest ranked European player from that extraction will be awarded with points for 1st position from Final Position Points Table (TW: 1,5)
- 3 2nd highest ranked European player from that extraction will be awarded with points for 2nd position from Final Position Points Table (TW: 1,5)
- 4 On that principle all European players from extraction from WR will be awarded with points from the Final Position Points Table
- 5 In case more players have the same number of points - points will be awarded according to WR position.

9.4. European Ranking U13 International Sanctioned Events

All ETTU Member Associations can apply their International event to be part of the ETTU Ranking System.

An International tournament can be ETTU ranking sanctioned event if following conditions are satisfied:

- minimum 5 Associations must participate at the event
- event shall not clash with other ETTU events
- ETTU has to approve competition dates and Prospectus
- Entry List - ITTF ID is mandatory
- extraction of results must be in specific form (TBA)
- The host Association must pay a fee of 300€ to ETTU, to be part of the ETTU Ranking System
- ER must be used for the Seeding List
- Tournament can't be part of WTT or ITTF tournament structure
- that events are also open for non European players

Tournament Weight: 0,2
 Duration of Points : maximum one year
 Points deduction: no
 Final Position Points Table: **equal** or **each** depending on playing system.

For each event, the ETTU Ranking Committee will publish the Final Position Points Table as part of the Prospectus



Victory points: for each win according to European Ranking List which will be used for Seeding List

Exception : Only players with ITTF ID will be included in ETTU Ranking

9.5. European Ranking U13 Regional Sanctioned Events

All ETTU Regional Associations can apply their International event to be part of the ETTU Ranking System.

Regional Tournament can be ETTU ranking-sanctioned event if the following conditions are satisfied:

- minimum 4 Associations must participate at the event
- the entries must be done through the NA-s
- event shall not clash with other ETTU events
- ETTU has to approve competition dates and Prospectus
- Entry List - ITTF ID is mandatory
- extraction of results must be in specific form (TBA)
- The Regional Association must pay a fee of 200€ to ETTU, to be part of the ETTU Ranking System
- ER must be used for the Seeding List
- Tournament can't be part of WTT or ITTF tournament structure

Tournament Weight: 0,1

Duration of Points : maximum one year

Points deduction: no

Final Position Points Table: **equal** or **each** depending on playing system.

For each event, the ETTU Ranking Committee will publish the Final Position Points Table as part of the Prospectus

Victory points: for each win according to European Ranking List which will be used for Seeding List

Exception : Only players with ITTF ID will be included in ETTU Ranking

9.6. Team Matches

For each win in the team matches, players will be awarded with victory points, according to the following table :

Event	Ranking which will be used for calculation of Victory Points	Duration of Points
ETC	actual ER which is used for the Seeding List for Individual Championships	1 year (ETC to ETC)
EYS	actual ER which is used for the Seeding List for Individual part of the EYS event	1 year; expiring next year on the same month on which they were included in the ranking

Points from all team competitions will be cumulated into one sum, and that sum will be considered as one event

10. ETTU RANKING PROTECTION

10.1. General Principles

- ETTU Ranking protection can be applied at all ETTU events for invitation, entry and seeding
- ETTU Ranking protection can be given when a player has received a Ranking protection by ITTF according to the ITTF Table Tennis World Ranking Regulation
- ETTU Ranking protection can be given to any other player according to this guideline

10.2. ETTU Ranking protection

- ETTU Ranking protection is the right of players to keep, for a limited period, the ranking points in the ETTU Ranking they had at the moment they requested it. These points shall be used for invitation, entry and seeding at ETTU events relevant for the player and included in the ETTU ranking (ETTU Ranking Rulebook chapter 4).
- ETTU Ranking protection shall be applied to the Singles, Doubles and Mixed Doubles competitions based on the corresponding ranking lists
- ETTU Ranking protection can be requested by the ETTU Member Association of a player if the player is injured, sick, pregnant or under any other circumstances that prevent him/her from competing in table tennis events, including sanctioned and non-sanctioned events, leagues of exhibitions for a time between 6 and 18 months
- The ETTU Ranking protection duration, the number of events or period when the entry and seeding using the protected ranking is applied, is determined by the duration of the player's absence. **If this is between 6 and 12 months**, the duration is 6 months after the start date of the first ITTF or ETTU sanctioned event where the player competes after the absence. **If this is between 12 and 18 months**, the duration is 9 months after the start date of the first ITTF or ETTU sanctioned event where the player competes after the absence
- In the case a player who returns to competition after an absence and gets injured again having a protected ranking status, a freeze of the status at that moment may be requested up to two times during the protection. The player's absence must be at least 3 months, after which the player would continue with the original protection and remaining months and events

10.3. Procedures

- The Ranking protection must be requested by the Member Association of a player within 6 months after the last sanctioned event where the player competed, by filling out and sending the form at <https://ittf.com/rankings> to the ETTU Ranking Committee Chair, with a copy to the ETTU Secretary General and the ETTU Competition Manager
- The decision to apply an ETTU Ranking protection will be made by the ETTU Ranking Committee
