As you all know, on 2nd March ETTU President Igor Levitin took the decision to self-suspend himself from all functions related to his position as ETTU President until further notice. He did so to protect the integrity of the ETTU and its events as well as the wellbeing of its athletes.

In his absence, as per the ETTU Constitution, Deputy President Pedro Moura is serving as Acting President on an interim basis. The Executive Board is working to ensure that the ETTU continues to operate as normal in full compliance with the ETTU Constitution, and our events go ahead as planned.

Our most recent event, the ETTU Top 16 Cup in Montreux was a state-of-the-art event and showcased European table tennis at its very best. Once again, we would like to thank the organisers for their excellent organisation and warm hospitality.

The Top 16 demonstrated the level at which we can host our events and we need to maintain and build on this in the months ahead.

There is no doubt that this is a challenging time. But together we can continue to progress and serve European Table Tennis.

As a Table Tennis family, we stand in solidarity with Ukraine and we are united in our hope that peace will soon return to Europe.


