# 03. EUROPEAN TEAM CHAMPIONSHIPS STAGE 2 HOSTS

- · The Executive Board will be pleased to receive applications from Associations wishing to host either the Men's stage 2 groups (5 groups, 17 teams, 4 competition tables, 4 practice tables) or the Women's stage 2 groups (4 groups, 14 teams, 4 competition tables, 4 practice tables) OR both the Men's and Women's stage 2 groups (9 groups, 31 teams, 7 competition tables, 7 practice tables). All matches shall be played on an ITTF approved floor.
- · Group winners and runners up will qualify for the final stage at Malmö.
- . 3<sup>rd</sup> place teams will enter a knockout play off for 1 Men's place and 2 Women's places at the final stage.
- · The dates for the stage 2 groups and knockout play off matches are Friday 5th to Sunday 7th May
