

Who Can Be a Candidate?

- 12 Age 16+
- Participated in at least one edition of European Championships or Para TT European Championships in the last 4 years
- No anti-doping/illegal betting sanctions

Nominated by your National Association (up to 2 candidates/NA)

- 2021 ETTC Cluj Napoca
- 2022 ETTC Munich
- 2023 ETTC Malmö
- 2023 PTTC Sheffield
- 2024 ETTC Linz





How to be a Candidate


Fill in the Candidature Form

Must be signed by your National Association and the candidate. Include all relevant information about your table tennis career.

Add a recent photo

Send by deadline to the ETTU General Secretariat

Submit all documents through your National Association by 6 August 2025 to the ETTU General Secretariat at registration@ettu.org and projects@ettu.org.

ETTU Executive Board Review

Reviews all applications for eligibility



Public Announcement

Eligible candidates announced publicly and campaigning starts



Campaign Rules

Timing Restrictions

No promotion before official candidate list is published


Allowed Promotion

Campaigning allowed after publication (social media, press, interviews, etc.)

ETTU Neutrality

ETTU remains strictly neutral and promotes all candidates equally.

Who Votes?




All athletes taking part in the European Championships can vote:


- European Team Championships Stage 1

- European Para Championships Helsingborg,
 SWE In person in Helsingborg
